The three levels of key personnel are:


- **General Personnel:** Personnel with any role in college emergency preparedness, incident management, or response.
- **Critical Personnel:** Personnel with a critical role in the response to a college emergency
- **Leadership Personnel:** Personnel with a leadership role in the response to a college emergency


